As we conclude our negotiation of a new Contract DE-AC34-00RF01904 for the closure of the Rocky Flats Environmental Technology Site, we have agreed to an effective date earlier than originally anticipated. I want to clarify the Department of Energy's (DOE) expectation regarding the continuation of approved procedures and systems as we move from our current contract to the new contract.

Many standard provisions from the Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR), Department of Energy Acquisition Regulations (DEAR), and DOE Orders incorporated in the new contract require DOE approval of procedures or systems. For example, the new contract provisions require approval of the contractor's purchasing system and property management system, among others.

It is not our intent or desire that Kaiser-Hill submit currently approved procedures or systems for re-approval under the new contract. To the extent that you are operating under a DOE-approved procedure or system, whatever the nature, the procedures and systems are approved going into the new contract.
